SR 260 Pavement Preservation Project

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) will begin a pavement preservation and refurbishment project on State Route (SR) 260 between Western Drive and just west of Fir Street in Cottonwood. The construction is expected to begin the week of April 20, 2009 and last approximately six weeks. The majority of the improvements will take place during the evening to limit the impact on traffic flow. Pavement preservation is a cost-effective practice that extends pavement life and improves motorist safety.

Noise generated from machinery may be audible during evening hours. Evening work is expected to last throughout the construction schedule. Construction noise exposure levels will be limited as best as possible during the evening work hours.

SR 260 Cherry Creek Safety Improvements

ADOT began construction of the SR 260 Cherry Creek Safety Improvements project mid March 2009. Construction is expected to last through Spring 2010. Traffic restrictions are expected throughout construction.

Planned Improvements:

- A signalized intersection will be installed at Cherry Road.
- The intersections of Horseshoe Bend and Old 279 with SR 260 will be improved.
- Highway shoulders will be widened at Park Verde.
- A left-turn lane will be added at Dickison Circle.
- Motorist sight lines will be improved by a reduction of the highway grade.
- Passing lanes will be added between Cherry Road and Coury Drive in both directions.
