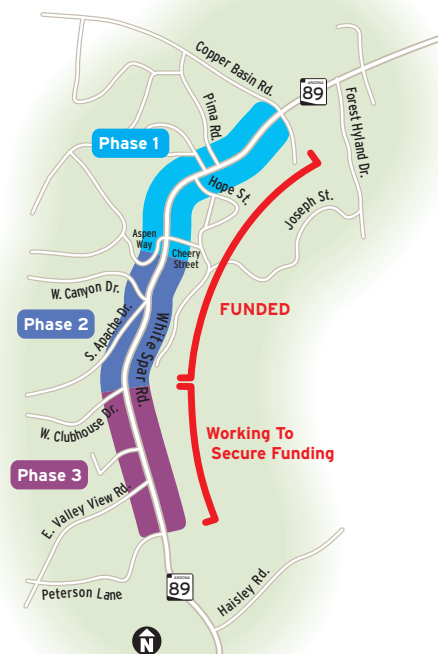

Planned Improvements

- Widen and repave road between Copper Basin Road and Peterson Lane, and install new roadway signs
- Add continuous left turn lane, bike lanes, and sidewalks, improving movement for motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians between Cheery Street and Copper Basin Road.
- Install curb and gutter, which defines the roadway, makes driveways safer and more visible, and improves drainage.
- Other drainage improvements.
- Retaining walls to stabilize road from the edges.
- New commercial and residential driveways.

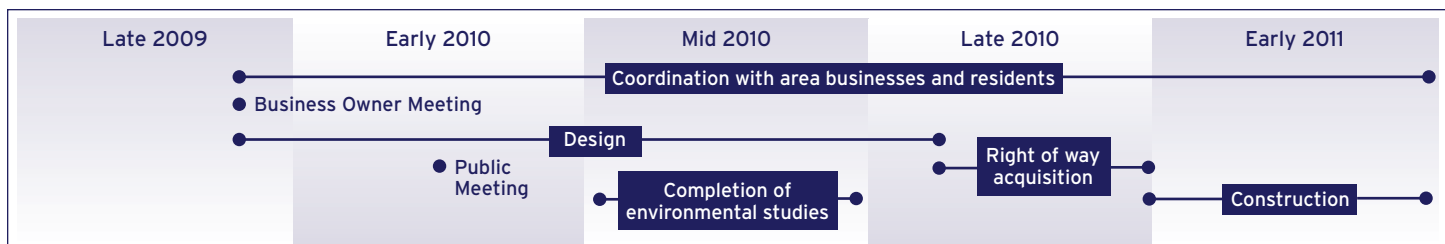
Notes

- **Retaining wall construction** is important for roadway stability in this hilly area.
- **Driveways will be rebuilt**, and driveway permits will be updated. The slopes of some driveways may change slightly.
- **Some right-of-way (property) may need to be acquired** permanently; some temporary easements will be acquired to allow construction activities on private property
